We are looking forward to welcoming you all to Summer School at **St Margaret's Church Hall, Queen's Rd, Ilkley LS29 9QL**. Please find some information below about the week and what you need to bring. As always if you have any questions or queries please get in touch.

Dates and Times

- Summer School runs from Monday 26th July until Friday 30th July.
- The day starts at 11:00am and finishes at 4:00pm

What to Wear and Bring

- Wear suitable dance clothing for each day with long hair tied neatly away from your face. On Friday please wear all black for the showing of work.
- If you have dance shoes please bring them, if not clean pumps or trainers and barefeet are fine.
- Bring an extra layer if the weather is cool as windows and doors will be open at all times to allow for adequate ventilation.
- We will not be able to allow anyone to leave to buy lunch so bring plenty of food and a water bottle.
- Parents and seniors will also need a face mask for entry and exit.

Showing of Work

- There will be 2 Free showings of work on Friday 30th July at 1:00pm and 3:00pm.
- Masks to be worn by audience members.
- We may also need to assign parents/carers to a showing of work depending on the space available.

Access and Parking

- Access to the hall is from the external stairs - please do not use the main Church Hall door.
- Parents must sign their child in and out from the registration desk at the top of the external staircase.
- Please park on Queens Road and not in Heather Court.

COVID 19

Please do not send your child to summer school if they are unwell or have been asked to isolate or someone in the household/bubble has tested positive for coronavirus in the last 10 days.

Whilst we understand most legal restrictions will have been lifted around wearing of masks etc we will still be following some rules to help prevent the spread of coronavirus.

- Ventilation in the hall will be kept at a maximum with doors and windows open.
- Only 1 person will be allowed in the toilet at a time.
- We will register the children outside before entry to the building to prevent close groups of people gathering inside.
- We ask that seniors and parents wear a mask unless exempt as they enter and exit the building.
- We ask that audience members wear a mask unless exempt when they watch the showing of work.
