

'ON BROADWAY' - At The Theatre

On show day and during rehearsals it is important that children come with plenty of water and healthy snacks, however we have some children with serious allergies so **no nuts please**.

Performance Times:

2pm Matinee: Arrive by 1:15pm. Students will be finished by 4:45pm.

Please collect children under 16 after the matinee. They cannot stay in the theatre in between shows as they will not be chaperoned.

6.30pm Evening Performance: Arrive by 5:45pm. Students will be finished by 9:15pm.

Tinies ('Be Our Guest', 'Surfs Up' & 'Woodland Ballet') will only be in the 2pm performance. All other cast members will be in both the 2pm and the 6:30pm performances.

Registration:

Everyone must register on entry and exit of the building at the tech rehearsal (Thursday 2nd), at the dress rehearsal (Friday 3rd) and on show day.

If dancers have dressing rooms in the Winter Gardens, they need to sign in and out at the registration desk.

Dancers in the Kings Hall Dressing Rooms must sign in and out on their dressing room door - the registration desk will be able to direct them, but not sign them in!

As well as the registration desk, Reps Troupe will be around in their red hoodies to direct students and answer any questions.

Supervision/Chaperones:

All students will be chaperoned by police checked (DBS) adults while at the theatre. No parents are allowed backstage if they are not helping, and no parents can watch rehearsals, apart from the Tinies Dress Rehearsal on Fri 3rd April (4.30-5.30pm).

Arrive promptly but not too early, as we cannot let you into the changing rooms before the chaperones are there.

Costumes:

Costumes must be brought in named bags or on named coat hangers - **make sure every item of clothing is named!**

For the finale, students must wear a Joze School of Dance t-shirt or zipped hoodie, with black bottoms of their choice.

These can be purchased from wharfedaleuniforms.com/joze but please order by March.

Once the show is over please make sure all costumes that need to be returned (see the lists in changing rooms at the theatre) are placed in the costume return boxes. **Do not take them home!**

Hair & Makeup

If possible **please have makeup & hair done before coming to the theatre** on Fri 3rd April & Sat 4th April. While there will be people on hand to help with hair and makeup when you arrive, not many people will be available. Please provide your own hair brush, bobbles, hairspray and makeup if you are wanting it to be done at the theatre.

Makeup: Foundation/powder, pink blusher, brown or grey eyeshadow, black or brown eyeliner above and beneath eyes, black mascara, red lipstick (false eyelashes for older girls)

Hair: French or Dutch plaits of any style
